Every UK company insolvency, the day it happens.

Summary

In June 2026, there were 1,845 registered company insolvencies in England and Wales (0% versus the previous month and –10% year on year).*

In June 2026, there were 1,845 registered company insolvencies in England and Wales. The total was broadly unchanged compared with May 2026 (1,849) and fell 10% against June 2025 (2,048). Creditors' voluntary liquidations remained the most common outcome, as they have throughout recent years.

Where the pressure sits

Across the cases InsolvencyRadar recorded in June, the busiest sectors were construction (303), hospitality & food service (266) and wholesale & retail (248). These industries consistently account for the largest share of company failures.

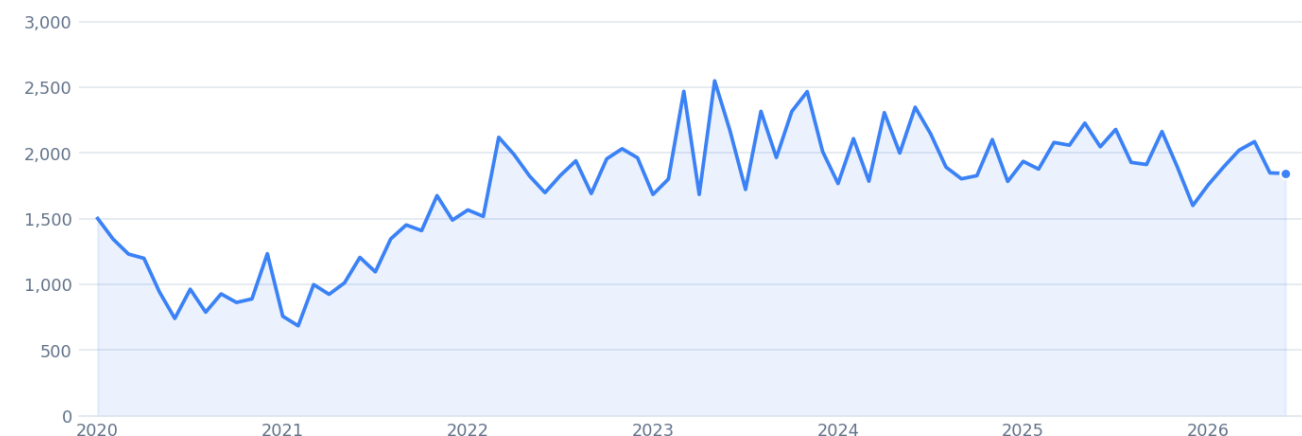
By region, London recorded the most insolvencies, ahead of North West and South East.

A number of long-established companies were among the month's insolvencies, including Fayers Plumbing & Building Supplies Limited, which had been trading since 1923.

* Headline totals are the official Insolvency Service company insolvency statistics for England and Wales. The industry and regional breakdowns in this report are derived from company insolvencies recorded by InsolvencyRadar (UK-wide), which the official monthly release does not break down, and are indicative of the distribution of cases.
